

Paper submission guidelines

Abstract:

Information abstract for research article: It should set out briefly and clearly the main objectives and results/conclusions of the work; it should give the reader a clear idea of what has been achieved. The length of the abstract should be a maximum of 300 words.

Abstract submission:

1. Title
2. Affiliation
3. Abstract
4. Keywords

Author Biography:

Biographies of the first author and/or the corresponding author within 150 words (including the author photos) should include educational background, research field, and published papers and patents, *etc.*. Please submit the biographies as a separate file.

Submission: (soft copies)

- ✓ Scanned copy of College ID Card along with Aadhar Card
- ✓ HoD or Principal approval letter

Full Paper

Following is the order of topics for full paper submission:

1. Title
 2. Affiliation
 3. Abstract
 4. Keywords
 5. Introduction
 6. Experimental Procedure
 7. Results and Discussions
 8. Conclusions
 9. Acknowledgements (If any)
 10. References
- Only "Times New Roman" font should be used and double spaced.
 - Full Paper must be written in English only using MS-Word (.doc or .docx format only).
 - Maximum numbers of authors are **FIVE**.
 - Full Paper should contain a maximum of 25 pages.
 - The text should be double spaced and should be typed in Times New Roman style with a font size of 12 pts and 1 inch margin all around. Use standard indentation for paragraphs.

1. Footnotes should appear at the bottom of the page on which they are cited/ referenced.
2. Tables and Figures should be numbered in Roman Numerals and can appear either in the body of the manuscript. Sources of data used in both tables and figures should be duly acknowledged as a footnote to the same. In case some abbreviations and acronyms are used in the tables and figures, these should be duly described in the main body text of the manuscript where they have been cited/ referenced/interpreted and well as in the footnotes of the table/ figure.
3. Tables and figures appearing at the end of the manuscript should be duly referenced in the main body text where these have been interpreted.
4. All Figures (charts, diagrams and line drawings) should be of clear quality, in black and white or color. For figures which cannot be supplied in MS Word, acceptable standard image formats are: tif, .jpeg (.jpg) , or .bmp at a resolution of at least 300dpi.
5. Equation editor should be used to type the mathematical equation used in the study.

Review Process

All received papers are initially scrutinized for suitability within the conference. If found suitable article will be further be sent to a technical team for review process. Based on the feedback, technical team decides to accept, reject or revise the paper. Normally review process takes much time to provide feedback to authors. Hence all the authors are requested to submit as soon as possible before the dead line.
